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Notification on the Launch of the Electronic Queue Reservation System in the Republic of Latvia

The Road Transport Administration of the Republic of Latvia hereby informs you that a new Electronic Queue Reservation System (ERRS) will be launched on 15 October 2025.

Starting from this date, all vehicles crossing the external land border of the Republic of Latvia at the Grebņeva, Terehova, and Pāternieki border crossing points will be required to register in the ERRS prior to arrival.

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Electronic Queue Reservation System to be launched in the Republic of Latvia on 15 October 2025

On 19 June 2025, the Saeima of the Republic of Latvia adopted amendments to the Law on the State Border of the Republic of Latvia, stipulating that starting from **15 October 2025**, all vehicles crossing the state external land border at the Grebņeva, Terehova, or Pāternieki border crossing points must be registered in the Electronic Queue Reservation System (ERRS).

From 15 October 2025, ONLY vehicles registered in the Electronic Queue Reservation System will be allowed to cross the external land border of the Republic of Latvia.

Early registration in the system will be available starting from 1 October 2025.

How to register in the ERRS

- Registration in the Electronic Queue Reservation System is available through the websites www.lvborder.lv or www.lvrobeza.lv.
- To register in the electronic queue, you will need to provide details about the vehicle (motorcycle, passenger car, bus, or truck), its driver, and cargo.

When to register in the ERRS

- Advance registration – up to 30 days before the planned border crossing. This will allow you to choose a specific time slot for crossing a particular border. After payment confirmation, the system will issue a queue number for crossing the border within the selected time slot (1 hour).
- Last-minute registration – shortly before arrival at the border crossing point – you will be assigned the first available time slot provided by the system.

Registration fee

The fee for registration in the electronic queue is EUR 9.30 per vehicle.

With the introduction of the ERRS in Latvia, this system will be in effect in all three Baltic states.
